Princess Plus vs. Premier Packages FAQ: Ultimate 2026 Guide

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Planning a Princess Cruise and wondering if upgrading your booking is worth the cost? You aren't alone. Deciding between the **Princess Plus** and **Princess Premier** packages is one of the biggest choices cruisers face before setting sail. This comprehensive FAQ breaks down everything you need to know to make an informed decision. From comparing daily pricing and beverage limits to exploring specialty dining upgrades, Wi-Fi perks, and crew appreciation fees, we've gathered all the details to help you find the perfect package for your vacation style and budget.

What is the pricing for each package?

When should I purchase these packages?

Guests under 21 are automatically assigned the Zero-Alcohol Package rather than Princess Plus or Princess Premier, so there's no need to select this separately. Note that the age threshold varies by region: it's 18 in Europe, Asia, South America, Australia, and New Zealand, and 20 in Japan. This package includes zero-alcohol cocktails, fountain sodas, specialty coffees and teas, frappes, and Red Bull energy drinks, with an 18% service charge pre-paid. Keep this in mind when budgeting for mixed-age traveling parties, since the automatic assignment means younger guests won't be charged for the full beverage package benefits adults receive.

Both Princess Plus and Princess Premier are available for all stateroom types, from interior cabins to suites. Guests can purchase either package before their cruise or onboard within the first two days of sailing. Booking ahead is worth noting for budgeting purposes: packages purchased at least 4 days (96 hours) prior to departure carry the lower pre-cruise price, while purchases made onboard or within 4 days of departure incur an additional \$5 per person per day. Guests under the minimum drinking age (21 in most regions, 18 in Europe, Asia, South America, Australia and New Zealand, or 20 in Japan) are automatically assigned the Zero-Alcohol Package instead.

What is non-refundable in these packages?

- Unused specialty dining, casual dining, and shore excursion credits are non-refundable if not used during the voyage and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- Crew Appreciation (pre-paid gratuities) is bundled with the package and cannot be opted out of, exchanged, or refunded — this applies at \$18 per person per day for interior, oceanview, and balcony staterooms; \$19 for mini-suites, cabanas, and Reserve; and \$20 for suites.
- Specialty dining meals included in a package are reserved exclusively for the package holder and cannot be transferred or used on behalf of another guest.
- Packages purchased onboard or within 4 days (96 hours) of departure incur an additional \$5 per person per day, and this surcharge is not waived retroactively.

Yes. Specialty dining meals included in the Princess Premier package (and any specialty dining credits tied to a beverage/dining package) are reserved exclusively for the package holder and cannot be transferred or used on behalf of another guest. If a specialty dining meal isn't used during the voyage, it is non-refundable and cannot be redeemed for cash.

Regardless of whether guests choose Princess Plus, Princess Premier, or no package at all, certain items remain free: breakfast ordered via the doorknob card stays complimentary, and any housekeeping items requested by telephone or through the stateroom steward remain free as well.

IMPORTANT

Princess updated its Plus and Premier package benefits on July 22, 2025. Guests who purchased a package before that date for a 2026 sailing will keep the 2025 benefits they originally booked, and those who purchased Princess Plus in 2025 for a 2026 sailing have the option to upgrade to the Premier Package. A further change takes effect January 14, 2026: the Premier Package will add casual dining at relaxed, sit-down restaurants such as Alfredo's Pizzeria, O'Malley's, Ocean Terrace, and Salty Dog Gastropub. Advisors should confirm a client's purchase date and sailing date before quoting benefits, since these grandfathering rules affect what's actually included. Note that benefit details for Sun Princess and Star Princess vary and should be checked separately.

Frequently asked questions

Do Princess Plus and Princess Premier include a Medallion accessory?

Yes, both packages include an exclusive free Medallion device accessory.

What are Princess Prizes, and are they included with these packages?

Both Princess Plus and Princess Premier include unlimited chances to win Princess Prizes, an onboard game where guests can win prizes ranging from onboard spending money to free cruises. Princess states that 1 in 4 spins wins a prize.

Is there a penalty for buying a package late or onboard?

Yes. Packages must be purchased at least 4 days (96 hours) prior to departure to get the lower price. Purchases made onboard or within 4 days of departure carry an additional \$5 per person per day.

Do package benefits vary by ship?

Yes. Sun Princess and Star Princess have benefit details that vary from other ships in the fleet and should be referenced separately when confirming inclusions for a specific sailing.

What happens if a guest purchased a package before the most recent update?

Packages were updated on July 22, 2025. Guests who purchased a package before that date for 2026 sailings will still receive the 2025 benefit structure. Guests who purchased Princess Plus in 2025 for a 2026 sailing also have the option to upgrade to Princess Premier.

Are there any casual dining changes coming for Princess Premier?

Effective January 14, 2026, Princess Premier will include casual dining at relaxed, sit-down restaurants such as Alfredo's Pizzeria, O'Malley's, Ocean Terrace, and Salty Dog Gastropub, among others.

What happens to unused dining meals or excursion credits?

Unused specialty dining, casual dining, and shore excursion credits are non-refundable if not used, and cannot be redeemed for cash.

Can crew appreciation (gratuities) be removed from these packages?

No. Crew appreciation is bundled into both packages and cannot be opted out, exchanged, or refunded.

Do guests under the legal drinking age get a beverage package automatically?

Yes. Guests under 21 (or 18 in Europe, Asia, South America, Australia, and New Zealand, or 20 in Japan) automatically receive the Zero-Alcohol Package, which includes zero-alcohol cocktails, fountain sodas, specialty coffees and teas, frappes, and Red Bull energy drinks, with a pre-paid 18% service charge.

Is complimentary breakfast still available regardless of package?

Yes. Breakfast ordered via the doorknob card remains complimentary, and housekeeping items ordered by telephone or through a steward remain free regardless of which package a guest has.
