Packing for a Virgin Voyages cruise is a little different than traditional cruising. Use this comprehensive packing list to ensure you have everything you need for the perfect sailing.

Essential Documents & The Basics

Don't leave home without these cruising necessities. Keep them in your carry-on bag so you have them on embarkation day before your luggage arrives at your cabin.

- Passport
- Boarding Pass / Mobile App
- Luggage Tags
- Credit Cards & Cash:** The ship is completely cashless, but you will want small bills for tipping tour guides or purchasing items in port.
- Medications:** Prescription medications in their original bottles, plus a mini first-aid kit with pain relievers and motion sickness remedies.
- Reef-Safe Sunscreen & Aloe:** Protect your skin and the ocean ecosystem.
- Reusable Water Bottle:** Essential for staying hydrated by the pool or during your stop at the Beach Club at Bimini.
- Wine & Champagne (Max 2 Bottles):** Virgin Voyages allows each cabin to bring up to two 750ml bottles of wine or champagne in your **carry-on luggage** on embarkation day. *Note: Liquor, beer, and corkscrews are prohibited, and a corkage fee applies if you drink your wine in the ship's restaurants!*

Daytime & Evening Apparel

Leave the tuxedo and the ballgown at home! Virgin Voyages embraces a "smart casual" atmosphere.

Virgin-Specific Theme Night Outfit

Virgin Voyages is famous for its immersive entertainment and theme nights. Be sure to pack these specific looks!

- A Touch of Red for Scarlet Night:** This is the signature party of the voyage. Go all-out in a fabulous red dress or sharp red suit, or keep it simple with red accessories.
- Fun Pajamas:** The first night usually features a massive Pajama Party. Bring your silk sets, fun onesies, or matching crew pajamas.
- 80s Workout Gear:** If you plan to sweat it out at the VHS (Video Hustle Studio) workout class, neon sweatbands, leotards, and bright leggings are highly encouraged.
- Chic Clubwear:** For dancing until the early hours at The Manor.

- ❑ **Swimwear (2-3 sets):** Plus stylish cover-ups for walking between your cabin and the Aquatic Club.
- ❑ **Casual Daytime Wear:** Shorts, t-shirts, sundresses, and breathable fabrics for port days and lounging.
- ❑ **Smart-Casual Evening Wear:** Think of what you would wear to a trendy restaurant in a major city. Dark denim, stylish tops, casual dresses, and rompers are perfect.
- ❑ **Light Jacket or Sweater:** The ocean breeze at night and the ship's air conditioning can be chilly.
- ❑ **Activewear:** For sunrise yoga, the running track, or the B-Complex gym

Footwear

- ❑ **Comfortable Walking Shoes:** Sneakers are a must for shore excursions and exploring ports of call.
- ❑ **Poolside Sandals:** Flip-flops or slides for the pool deck and the beach.
- ❑ **Dressier Shoes:** Stylish flats, wedges, or loafers for dinners and nightlife.

Must-Have Cabin Hacks

- ❑ **Heavy-Duty Magnetic Hooks** (Paid Link): The walls in your cabin are made of metal. Bring magnetic hooks to hang up hats, lanyards, and wet swimsuits to free up valuable closet space.
- ❑ **Non-Surge Multi-Plug Outlet / European Adapter** (Paid Link): Cruise ship cabins have limited outlets. A cruise-approved (non-surge) power strip gives you extra USB and AC ports. ***Pro-tip:*** *Virgin cabins feature both US and EU outlets, so bringing an EU adapter allows you to utilize those extra plugs!*
- ❑ **Pop-Up Mesh Laundry Hamper** (Paid Link): Cabin closets are wonderfully designed but compact. A cheap, collapsible laundry basket fits perfectly in the closet corner to keep your dirty clothes organized and out of the way.
- ❑ **Portable USB Fan** (Paid Link): While the cabins have great air conditioning, a small rechargeable or USB fan is perfect for extra air circulation and provides excellent white noise while you sleep.
- ❑ **Travel-Size Wrinkle Release Spray:** Traditional clothing irons and handheld steamers are prohibited on board due to fire regulations. A good wrinkle release spray will keep your dinner outfits looking crisp without a trip to the ship's laundry service.
- ❑ **Motion-Sensor Nightlight:** Cabins get pitch black with the blackout curtains drawn. A small, magnetic, or battery-operated nightlight for the bathroom saves you from turning on the harsh main lights in the middle

of the night

- Bathroom Odor Eliminator:** Cruise ship bathrooms are notoriously small. A travel-sized neutralizing bathroom spray is a small courtesy you and your cabinmate will be incredibly glad you packed!.

Toiletries & Extras

- Deodorant, Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Hairbrush, comb, and styling accessories
- Makeup and Daily Skincare routine
- Small Daypack or Beach Bag:** For carrying your essentials during port days and excursions.
- Entertainment:** A good book or downloaded podcasts for lounging in your iconic balcony hammock!

ADVISOR TIP

Note on Lanyards: You won't need a lanyard for a cruise card! Virgin Voyages utilizes a wearable, eco-friendly bracelet called "The Band" that serves as your room key, ID, and onboard payment method.
